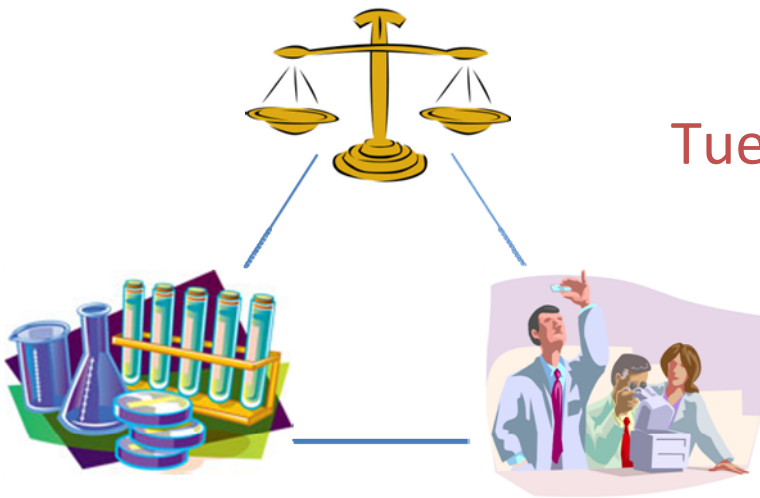


Navigating Intellectual Property Rights in Biomedical Research
